

Temporary Crown Placement

"Be careful!"

You have just had a tooth repaired and a temporary restoration placed on that tooth. Please follow these instructions to ensure comfort and care for your tooth. We also want to protect the tooth from further damage during this stage of the treatment.

Post treatment instructions.

- 1. Stay away from sticky, chewy, and hard foods (ex: dried fruit, candies and nuts).
- 2. When flossing, pull floss out sideways toward your cheek. Do not pull down between teeth.
- 3. Brush gently around the temporary crown.
- 4. If you feel any high spots when you bite down, please call the office immediately.
- If the crown comes off, please recement it with over the counter temporary cement or denture adhesive (ex: Polygrip or Fixodent) and call the office immediately.
- 6. Temporarily crowned teeth may be sensitive to cold, hot, or pressure while chewing. Feel free to take an over the counter pain medication (ex: Tylenol, ibuprofen) as needed.
